Parking

Parking at all parks will be extremly busy. We recommend that all teams plan ahead and have enough time to park and make it to your playing field on time.

Newton Athletic Park

DO NOT park in No Parking areas; including on yellow curbs or blocking entrance/exits. Overflow parking is available across the street at the elementary school or one block south at the Kwantlen University.

We recommend parking in the bigger parking lot off of 168th Street.

Headquarters

All Parks will have a Headquarters tent.

Staff will be available at the tent throughout the weekend if you have any questions.

The fastest way to get in touch with staff during the event is to visit a HQ tent.

Warm Up Areas

There are no assigned warm-up spaces, they are all first come first served. If you are not sure of an area in your park visit the HQ tent.

CAP - turf area between Field 1 & 2

SSAP - turf area behind Field #9 or grass between fields 9 & 10

NAP - large grass area that runs around field #3 to the South and West

Willoughby - small grass areas around all the fields

In the Parks

First Aid

There will be a First Aid/Athletic Therapist available near the Headquarters at each park. If there is an injury on a field and the player can not walk to First Aid find the closest Field Marshal or send someone to headquarters and they will have First Aid come to the field.

Ice bags will be available for minor injuries at the first aid area, please bring athlete to the area to be assessed by the First Aid attendant

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY ALWAYS CALL 911

Depending on availability Atheltic Therapists may be available to tape players before games for a nominal fee.

Jean Meeting Spot

We recommend all teams plan to meet in a certain area of the park before their games. The parks will be busy and it can be hard to find your team.
